In response to the national emergency duto the COVID-19 pandemic, et/Sysem Office is issuing a guiding memo for temporary amendment to tendirect placement policy for MAT 271: Calculus I.

A student may pacedirectly into MAT 271 if the student has met at least en(1) of the following criteria within the past five (5) years additions in bold):

A score of 2 or higher on the AP Calus AB Exam.

A grade of C or higher in an AP Calculus coants an unweighted HS GPA of 3.0 or higher.

A score of 90 or higher on the ACCUPLACER GbegeMath (CLM) test.

A score of 46 or higher on the trigonometry section of the ACT Compass**PM** ment Test.

A score of 580 or higher on the old (prior to March 2016) SAT Math and a grade of C or higher in the North Carolina Standard Course of Study Caleulus course or an equivalent course from another state (NOTE: Neither Math 4 nor Advanced Functions and Modeling meets this criterion.)

A score of 600 or higher on threw (March 2016 and beyond) SAT Math and a grade of C or higher in the North Carolina Standard Course of Study Cateulus course or an equivalent course from another state NOTE: Neither Math 4 nor Advanced Functions and Modeling meets this criterion.]

A score of 27 or higher on the ACT Math and a grade of C or higher in the Orthodolina Standard Course of Study Posticulus course or an equivalent course from another state.

A score of 560 or higher on the SAT Subject Test in Mathematics LEVETZE: Neiter Math 4 nor Advanced Functions and Modeling meets this criterion.]

Local diagnostic exam or challenge exam which demonstrates proficiency in Challenge course(s) competencies NOTE: This will be the Accuplable Generation Advanced Algebra and Functions placement test.]

An unweighted HS GPA of 3.5 or higher and a grade of C or higher in the North Carolina Standard Course of Study P@alculus course or an equivalent course from another state. [NOTE: Neither Math 4 nor Advanced Functions and Modeling meets this criterion.]

The MAT 271 Placement Team will reassess the this temporary placement option to extend beyond fall 2020 or become the permanent direct placement policy for MAT 271 later in the fall 2020 term.
